STUDY GROUP AND CLASS SEATING Mrs. G.W. Ballard From the Round Table Talks

Q. Would you say once again something about the Group scattering all over the auditorium instead of grouping close together and concentrating the Power?

Mrs. G.W. Ballard:

Yes. When people sit far apart, the thought—not the thought form, but the energy that is released, as it becomes luminous within the room—is just the difference between water concentrated or vapor out here. When you get it together, it is far more powerful in its action than if it were just scattered and everything goes off to the side.

Most people do not realize what is built in a Classroom when we give our Life Energy. Remember, It's Life. And that Energy and Vibration that goes forth through Our Music and Decrees and the Invocation and Benediction—that is all an Action of the Cosmic Light and the Sacred Fire. It's also the Action of the Love of Our "Presence" and the Love from the Ascended Masters and Cosmic Beings. And therefore—it doesn't mean we have to sit on top of each other or bang up against somebody; but generally, if there is a concentration of the Student Body toward the center of the room, and all are reasonably close together, it's much easier for the Group Leader to talk. And it's easier to keep the Students all together in rhythmic action when they give the Decrees; so it's just the right, natural, harmonious thing to do. 580918.3
