

(Excerpts from Beloved Pearl's Discourse, Denver, Colo., Youth Group— March 11, 1939.)



WISH to call your attention to-day, beloved ones, and to the older ones as well, in this quiet atmosphere, to the truth concerning marriage.

In the Octaves of Light, there is no giving in marriage. There is only the activity of the two Rays which came forth from the One Great Flame of Life, as you have seen illustrated in the magazine. Only in the human octave are the mistakes of human marriage made. It is not that marriage should cease in the human octave, but those who understand the Presence of Life should call for Wisdom to direct them, so no mistakes be made. The Wisdom of your "Mighty I AM Presence" will direct you. If your Life Stream requires the association of another, the correct individual will be brought to you, who will be harmonious. Then, it can intensify your companion's and your own Light to the Perfection of both.

We must make the following more clear and firm in each class. When people come into this Understanding—both the young and older people—and after a lifetime of great inharmony, begin to feel harmonious to each other, do not misinterpret that harmony as a desire for human companionship. A vast number of the students

have ofttimes misinterpreted it as such. Sometimes that might be true, but be sure of it before you take such a step.

Please listen to Me—this is the most vital thing among the students of mankind to-day. Marriage in its Purity in the human octave is a magnificent thing; but marriage through human desire is a tragedy as you all know quite well. The "I AM" Students of to-day are not subject to those conditions if they will wait and call earnestly to the "Mighty I AM Presence" for Its Wisdom to direct them. If such a condition seems apparent in one's Life, the individual should call earnestly and wait until he or she is sure; then no mistakes can be made. This will do more to encourage others of humanity to enter into the Glory of this Great Truth of Life, than perhaps any other one thing.
